
- 1. All entries must be staged and ready for judging by 12:30 p.m., Wednesday, August 28. Judging will start immediately. Positively no entries will be accepted after that time.
- 2. Out-of-state exhibitors welcome. Entry tags will be furnished free of charge. All exhibits shall be marked by a tag giving the Division and Classification number, name of variety & name & address of exhibitor. APPLY TO: FRED MILLER, 5167 HILL TOP ROAD, SYRACUSE, NY 13215-1401.
- 3. Classification number of variety shall be entered on Entry Tag according to the current N.A.G.C. classification lists. Recognized varieties not in the list may be exhibited in their proper classes.
- 4. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor, except vases, baskets and arrangements.
- 5. Up to two florets may be removed without penalty.
- 6. No exhibitor shall compete in more than one class or division unless selected by judges to compete for Championship. **Each specimen must be a different variety** with the exception of baskets and vases.
- 7. Stems for 300, 400 and 500 size classes not to exceed 20" plus or minus 1" from table to the lowest point of the bottom floret. 100-200 size classes not to exceed 17" plus or minus 1".
- 8. Containers will be furnished for all entries, except baskets, vases and arrangements. Please label with return address.

- 9. Merit judging will be used in all classes. Based on North American Gladiolus Council Judging Criteria and Standards.
- 10. All flowers staged for competition shall become the property of the Empire State Gladiolus Society.
- 11. Ribbons shall not be awarded to entries, which, in the opinion of the judges, are unworthy.
- 12. Seedlings may be shown in all Divisions (except Div. K).
- 13. Arrangement Rules
 - Rule 1 Use legend card accompanying arrangements. This is required.
 - Rule 2 Gladiolus must dominate in all arrangements.
 - Rule 3 Foliage other flowers and a minimum of dried, painted or treated material may be used, if so desired.
 - Rule 4 Accessories, figurines, or bases permitted.
 - Rule 5 Artificial fruits or vegetables are not allowed. If arrangement contains "fresh" fruits or vegetables it must be maintained by exhibitor.
 - Rule 6 All arrangements, baskets and vases must be made by exhibitor who shall assume full responsibility for property used in arrangements.
 - Rule 7 No protected plant material is to be used.
 - Arrangements will be judged according to North American Gladiolus Council Judging Criteria and Standards.
- 14. Blue Ribbon winners, which proceed in the judging, will receive money only for highest honor received. Intermediate honors will not carry monetary awards. All gladiolus awarded with ribbons in the first round of judging that go no further in the awarding of honors will receive monetary awards as stated in Groupings below.
- 15. The Judges' decisions are final.
- 16. The use of plant material on the NYS Conservation list is not permitted. Artificial plant materials, painted or dyed fresh plant materials are not allowed. The American flag is not to be used.

ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

There are two classes for each SPIKE DIVISION: The Gardener's Class and the Commercial Class. The Gardener's Class is for those that grow fewer than 750 gladioli in their garden. The Gardener's Class Divisions include: A, AA, AAA, B, C, D, E, G, K and L. The Vases, Baskets, Arrangement, People's Choice, and Decorative Divisions are not included in the Gardener's Class, but anyone can enter.

To participate in the Gardener's Class, please include a "G" after the division that you wish to enter the specimen in and place it on the table under that division. For example, Division "A" and "A - G" will be placed in Division A on the show table. Each spike division will have two winners, one from the Gardener's Class, and one from the Commercial Class.
