RULES AND REGULATIONS

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS-PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THESE RULES ARE PART OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH ALL ENTRIES ARE MADE

- Entries **MUST** be received by the Horse Show Secretary on or before the closing dates.
- **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted at regular fees after the closing date if stabling is available. Post entries for classes that are scheduled to run during the morning session must be made by 6:00 PM of the previous day. All other post entries for the day should be made by 11:00 AM on the day they are scheduled. **ENTRIES CLOSE AUGUST 14**
- Digital Exhibitor Passes will be emailed after entries are submitted.
- Your NYS SFS Number must be submitted with your entries **IN ORDER TO PROCESS YOUR PREMIUM CHECK.**
- Premium checks are made payable to, and are mailed to, the owners of the horses as stated on the entry blank. Premium vouchers will not be processed without owners' SFS#, full addresses and email addresses.
- If horses are entered and not exhibited, stall fees will be forfeited.
- The management reserves the right to decline any entry without being liable for compensation of any kind.
- All entries must be made by exhibitor or his authorized agent, and no animal will be admitted or stabled unless properly entered. Exhibitors or their agent are responsible for the accuracy of their entries. Errors, omissions or substitutions must be reported before the show starts to avoid post entry fees. The horse show will not be responsible for exhibitors losing points because their entries are not complete.
- The Management reserves the right to cancel any class or division not having sufficient entries by notifying the exhibitors and refunding the entry fees.
- **REFUNDS** : No refunds will be made without approval of management and Audit & Control. All refunds must be requested and all paper work supporting the request must be delivered to the horse show secretary before 10 AM on 8/25. No refunds on stalls. In the event that a horse is scratched, the stall reverts to the show and under no circumstances may be sold or reassigned without management approval. There will be a \$50.00 processing charge for all scratches after the closing date.
- **REFUNDS OF ENTRIES ONLY** for the bona fide reasons (i.e. illness of exhibitor and/or horses verified by medical or veterinarian's certificate) must be requested and all paper work supporting the request must be delivered to the horse show secretary before 10 AM on 9/2.
- The Management of this show and the New York State Fair will not be responsible for any accident of any kind or nature that may occur to any animal, person or property. The exhibitors and spectators shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings arising from any accident damages.
- No person will be allowed in the ring during the time of the judging except those who have to duties to perform.
- Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges and horse show officials on the part of the owners, riders, drivers or grooms shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall there by forfeit his entry fee and premium awards.
- All attendants in charge of animals will be subject to the orders of the Superintendent of the Horse Show. **ATTENDANTS MUST BE PROPERLY ATTIRED IN THE RING AND MUST ENTER THE RING THROUGH A GATE. SLEEVELESS SHIRTS AND/OR SHORTS ARE NOT APPROPRIATE.**
- The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and also the show ring if necessary to maintain scheduled time of classes.
- A number will be assigned to each horse or exhibitor when entry is made. This number must be displayed whenever the horse or exhibitor competes. Judges are entitled to refuse an award to any exhibitor not displaying an entry number.
- The right is reserved to withhold the prizes awarded in every case in which it shall appear to the management that the regulations have not been complied with or that fraud or deception has been attempted, or where the article or animal is not worthy, and its decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
- The premium portion of Added Classes will be mailed. The New York State Fair assumes no responsibility for the guarantee of payment of special awards offered by others.
- Every horse will be charged a \$30.00 Non-refundable Office Fee. (\$15 Exhibitor Fee & \$15 Processing Fee)
- In the Draft Halter Division: All horses showing in the group classes must show in their respective open class and must wear the ribbon won in that open class.(No Ribbons From Special Classes such as Futurity or Best-Bred
- Exhibitors are not permitted to bring and operate any type of motorized vehicle (golf carts, scooters, gators, etc.)

- All hitch classes, except cart and tandem classes, will be shown to fifth-wheel wagons. Draft and commercial vehicles; purebred or grade horses, to be shown in harness before a suitable working vehicle.
- One driver only and one attendant on wagon.
- Driver and attendant to be properly attired. In double-line classes, passengers should be capable drivers.
- No Alcohol permitted while competing.
- It is strongly recommended no passengers under the age of 10.
- Management reserves the right to refuse to allow any hitch to enter any class and/or to allow the judge to excuse any hitch from any class without being liable for any compensation of any kind.
- In the event management determines that it is in the best interest of the horse show to split classes in this division, premium money and added money will be reallocated. If there are fewer than four entries in any section, it may be combined with another section.
- Juniors may drive geldings or mares only. Accompanying adults should remain on the cart or wagon at all times in the Youth classes. If a header is required, another person, from outside the ring should come in to head the entry.
- Headers must wear ties and jackets or other appropriate attire.
- No Blue Jeans Or Tee Shirts In The Arena Please!
- Headers are encouraged in all hitch classes, however no one will be permitted to stand inside the ring during the performance.
- All scratches must be made with LIZ two hours prior to the start of the session.
- **Adds must be made the day prior to the scheduled class**
- Once the gate has been closed on a class, it will not be reopened for late arrivals.
- In the event of a lost shoe outside the show ring or a tack/equipment problem Show Management will determine whether the gate can be held or not.
- Show Management has the right to adjust the heats per their discretion
- In the Draft Halter Division: All horses showing in the group classes must show in their respective open class and must wear the ribbon won in that open class.
- **There will be a 1-2 minute gate call between halter classes- there will be no exceptions**
- Horses showing in halter are permitted to stay for the duration of the hitch classes.
- Halter horses will not be permitted to move out during show hours. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Absolutely no move-in or move-out during show hours - **PLAN ACCORDINGLY - No Exceptions**
- Move out will be scheduled by Liz. No one will be permitted to move out during show hours
- During moving in and moving out please be courteous of your fellow exhibitors and do not block the shoot
- Absolutely no modifications of stalls unless pre-approved by LIZ

STABLING

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Temporary and permanent stabling. All horses shown must be stabled. No doors shall be removed from a box stall or stalls altered in any manner by an exhibitor. Anyone desiring to have a door removed will come to the office and management will have it removed and stored for them. Exhibitor shall be held responsible for any damages. Stall assignments will be made by the Superintendent. Special requests or changes must be approved by LIZ PINTO stabling but management DOES NOT GUARANTEE that all requests will be honored and will not consider unfilled requests a bona fide reason for cancellation and/or refund.

BLOCK STABLING

Individuals and members of larger stables wishing to stable together must send entries together and clearly indicate with whom the entry should be stabled. Otherwise, management will not be responsible for these requests. Space is provided on the entry blank for indicating with whom such exhibitors will stable. TACK STALLS may be limited. Exhibitors sharing a tack stall must submit their entries together.

All Horses Coming To The Main Barns Will Enter Gate 7, Turn Left and Drive To The Barns. After Unloading, Ask For Directions To The Black Lot.

All Paperwork Will Be Checked & Verified In the Horse Show Office. No Numbers Will Be Released Until The Proper Paperwork Is On File In The Show Office.

HORSE HEALTH INFORMATION

ALL COGGINS PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY ANIMALS ON TO THE GROUNDS.

All New York State horses must have had a Coggins test in calendar year 2023 or 2024.

All out-of-state horses must have had a Coggins test with one (1) year entry into New York State. All out-of-state horses must also have CURRENT INTERSTATE HEALTH PAPERS, DATED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE HORSES' ENTRY INTO NEW YORK STATE. HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE WITH THE HORSE AND PRESENTED AT THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL. **All Animals 105 days of age or older on the date of arrival at the fair must be vaccinated for rabies. The vaccine must be administered at least 14 days prior to arrival on the fairgrounds but no greater than the labeled time specified for active protection against rabies.** The animal's rabies vaccination status must remain current throughout its stay on the fairgrounds.

Booster Vaccination: Animals previously vaccinated for rabies but whose vaccine status has expired, are eligible for exhibition upon receiving a booster vaccination. This booster must be given at least **3 days prior** to arrival at the Fair. ***Proof of previous vaccination is REQUIRED.***

PARKING

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

EXHIBITOR RV PARKING

Temporary RV parking must be requested on line. Please note that all RV parking for exhibitors in the Toyota Coliseum area will be located across State Fair Blvd in the Pink Lot. (See Map) All RV parking is nonrefundable. All In the Main Barn area, RV units will be accommodated in the Pink parking lot. Tow vehicles may remain attached, in most instances. Directions for access to the parking area will be sent with the stickers. Spaces will be numbered and exhibitors will be assigned a specific space. Temporary RV spaces include electricity, water and sewage pumpouts. The Pink RV Lot has enhanced electrical services and a shower and rest room facility. Pumpouts are included in the parking fee. Gate 4 will remain open 24 hours a day, every day, for access to the horse barn area. Exhibitors with campers will be issued passes for easy access through Gate 4 by surrendering their passes in the downstairs show office. Exhibitors stabling in the race barns will be assigned temporary RV parking in the Green area. These RVs may arrive at any hour and will be able to leave tow vehicles attached. Hookups in this area include sewers. Spaces will be allocated on a first-come basis by the Superintendent. Requests will not be honored unless approved by the Superintendent. Any changes must be approved by the Superintendent.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

Exhibitor passes will be emailed to the owners, as submitted online, for the days that their horses are showing.

VETERINARIAN

The Official Veterinarians reside are designated to make official inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of a Veterinarian is required. In addition, they may be contacted through the Barn Office whenever you require their services.

HORSE VEHICLE PARKING

All Horse Transport Trucks and Trailers must park in the Black Livestock Trailer lot.

Horse trailers carrying horses, that arrive between 6 AM and 11 PM, must enter through Gate 7. After unloading horses, exit Gate #7 (get hand stamped for re-entry) and enter Gate #7. Go straight down the perimeter road and follow signs to Livestock Vehicle Parking. Between 11 PM and 8 AM, enter gate 7 and then enter the Fairgrounds at Gate 11. Try not to arrive during these hours, if at all possible, for your own convenience.

Horse vehicles will NOT have to drive through the heaviest pedestrian traffic areas on their way to and/or from the barns. **The Livestock Vehicle parking area will be supervised to facilitate organized parking that will keep all vehicles accessible at all times.**
